


- Includes 967 OVC in our program in Namibia: 25% orphans & 75% vulnerable children.
- Collected August 2008 and re-collected February 2009.
- Now collected routinely every 6 months.


## **Average Well-Being Score**




### **Average Achievement by Domain**





- Collection is ongoing and data is collected every 6 months.





## Proportion of Children Achieving ALL Six Indicators in Domain



Namibia 3,513 OVC average 73%




### Conclusions

- High tool acceptability among field staff, volunteers, and caregivers
- Serves as a case management tool to focus interaction with caregiver
- Empowers caregivers
- Facilitates targeting most vulnerable populations



### **More Conclusions**



- Effective for assessing program impact in Namibia... showing 15% improvement in child well-being
- Useful in prioritizing program responses...identified greatest needs in health & PSS
- Renewed attention to the needs of <u>all</u> children in the household is warranted
